It is your responsibility to have yourself and your horse ready to compete and in the arena on time. Any late riders will not be permitted into the arena and will be eliminated from that competition. The organizing committee reserves the right to cancel or combine any classes as needed.

Riders may use snaffle bits and ride two handed in Western Classes but will be judged accordingly. Junior riders may carry a crop or use martingales in flat classes.

Riders in the Trot Pole classes may be on leadline or have an adult/coach in the arena with them.
